Committees/Board

- **Building & Grounds:** addresses maintenance issues and plans major building projects.
- **Church in Community:** organizes community aid for HALO, Hospitality Center etc.
- **Council:** Oversees the larger church strategy and long range planning.
- **Endowment Board:** manages the investment and financial disbursements of the Endowment fund.
- **Finance Committee:** manages the financial oversight and stability of the church and provides annual budget recommendation.
- **Membership:** focuses on building strong fellowship within the church with a focus on welcoming new and potential members.
- **Parish Education:** Oversight of Sunday School, First Communion, Confirmation and other teachings opportunities.
- Stewardship: Plans and executes the Stewardship annual campaign.
- **Worship:** plans and supports the worship service activities such as communion, baptisms, scripture readers, ushers, etc.
- Youth: supports youth activities in the church including mission trips, youth nights, etc.

Worship Service

- Altar Group: prepares and cleans up the altar before and after services. Choir/Worship Band: provides music to enhance and support worship services.
- **Communion Assistant:** Aids in the distribution of communion during worship
- **Computer/Sound Assistant:** runs the projection and sound system equipment during services.
- Greeter: greets and welcomes all attending services.
- Scripture Reader: Reads the scriptures during worship services.
- **Usher:** Responsible for distribution of the worship program and The Cross, ushering during communion, and collecting offering.
- **Summer Band Equip. set up/take down:** Insures proper set up/take down of the band equipment during summer outside services.
- **Nursery Helper:** Supervises children in the nursery during services.
- **Offering Counter:** Assists the Lead Counter to insure proper counting and recording of all funds collected.
- **Scrip Table Assistant:** Sells the scrip cards and insures proper recording of all sales.

Ministry Groups:

- **Green Team:** supports all areas around church and community related to Green programs and activities.
- Knit Wits: knits prayer shawls for those members in need.
- Library Assistant: provides library duties and purchase of books.
- Prayer Chain: prays for those requesting support.
- Sew & Sews: Sews Quilts, book bags, etc for Lutheran World Relief.
 Visiting Angels: visits the homebound and sick of our congregation.
 Women of Resurrection: connects all women members with opportunities such as Brown Bag Bible study, Bible Circle, and Caring Connection.

Projects/Activities:

Cooking/Kitchen: food preparation for funerals and special events. **Confirmation/Small Group Leader:** Lead learning groups such as Confirmation. **Cradle Roll:** support the new born through pre-schoolers with Christian learning

- tools that are mailed periodically throughout the year.
- **Decorating for Church Holidays:** Creating new decorations and helping to decorate the church for Holidays and special events.
- Mission Trips: Attend Adult mission trips and/or supervise youth trips.
- Sewing: Sewing Banners, Costumes, Decorations as needed for various events.
- **Summer Neighborhood Camp:** Leading camp activities, reading to small groups, helping with meals, etc.
- **Sunday School Teacher/helper:** leading or aiding in the teachings of the church for the church youth.
- Writing Thank You Notes: Assist the church in writing thank you notes for donations received by the church, for example memorials.
- Youth Night Assistant: assisting the Youth Leader in planning and implementing the various activities for the Youth Night program.

Reach out to Service Teams:

- **HALO:** delivery of collected items, cleaning, painting, repairing, organization of HALO facilities
- **Community Meals:** preparation, delivery and servicing of various community meals Hospitality Center, Living Faith, and St. Patrick's.
